Housing Information

Deposits (due at time of registration)

\$100 Key and Housing Deposit (Lost key = \$50)

Key and Housing deposits will be returned on the last day of the visitor's stay provided all keys are returned and the rooms and facilities are not damaged by the participant. Please keep the deposit fee and room reservation fee separate. This will insure a speedy return of deposit.

Check In/ Check Out

All students are to check in between 4:00 – 5:00 PM on the Sunday before their workshop or camp begins. Students should check in at the main desk in the Texas building located on the first floor, students will then be driven to the RMCAD Student Housing at Terra Village apartments for room assignments. Check out time is Friday morning prior to the start of classes. Please note: current RMCAD students will also be living in student housing over the summer trimester. **All parents are expected to and must pick their student(s) up at the close of classes on Friday at the main gallery in the Texas building and/or make arrangements for their student to be taken to the Denver International Airport, bus terminal or train station. Departing transportation will not be provided by RMCAD.**

RMCAD Student Housing at Terra Village

Room Rates per week: \$185 One and two bedroom/Multiple Occupancy Apartment

(Price includes five-night stay at RMCAD apartment complex, continental breakfast, dinner, bed linens, evening activities and RMCAD staff member/ chaperon)

Room Rates for Three Weeks: \$555 One and two bedroom/Multiple Occupancy Apartment

(Price includes three week stay at RMCAD apartment complex, continental breakfast, dinner, bed linens, evening activities and RMCAD staff member/chaperon)

RMCAD Student Housing at Terra Village

RMCAD leases and operates apartment buildings near campus for student housing. The student housing apartments provide students with a community living environment, close to campus and exclusively for our RMCAD students. Some of the amenities and benefits of the apartments includes a on-site residence chaperons and professional staff, pool, basketball courts, coin operated laundry facilities, and a shuttle bus between RMCAD and the apartments several times a day. All apartments are furnished with a bed, desk/drafting table, lamp, shower curtain and chest of drawers for each student, as well as living room furniture. Heat, water and electricity are included. Local phone service is not included. All students are encourage to bring their own cell phone or calling card.

Linens

Sheets, blankets, pillows and pillowcases and towels are provided with all housing accommodations.

Smoking

Smoking is prohibited in all public areas of the building, including lounges, laundry room, and courtyards. Should a student choose to smoke in his/her room, we thank you in advance for being respectful of your non-smoking neighbors. Please be aware that, the need for smoke-free air will have priority, and should his/her smoke encroach on other residents' space, you will be required to smoke outside.

Drugs/ Alcohol & College Regulations

Colorado law stipulates that only a person 21 years of age or older may possess and consume alcoholic beverages. The illegal use of drugs or alcohol by minors is not permitted on the RMCAD campus or in the apartments. Violation of this policy will result in termination of stay and all deposits and registration fees will be forfeited.

All students are required to adhere to all college policies, regulations, guidelines and all local, state and federal laws concerning health, safety and public order. Failure to comply with these regulations may result in forfeiture of all deposits and registration fees. A BAUHAUS handbook with complete regulations, and guidelines regarding overnight stay at the apartments will be mailed to all students utilizing the apartments during the CE summer programs.

Prior to start of programs, parental release forms will be mailed to all pre-college high school juniors and seniors. Forms must be signed by student and parent/guardian and returned to RMCAD before the student will be admitted to the program.

Age Requirements

Student housing is available to high school juniors and seniors only. A RMCAD staff member will be available in the evenings in case of emergencies.

Pets

Pets are not permitted in the apartment facility.
