ACADEMIC	RMCAD Academic Scholarship	The Academic Scholarship is awarded to incoming new students with a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.5 on a 4.0 scale. The Academic Scholarship may be combined with other scholarships and can be applied to tuition and fees. In order to maintain the scholarship, students must maintain a 3.5+ GPA, have all tuition balances paid in full every term, or have a current payment plan in place.	Students will be automatically considered for the Academic Scholarship — no separate application is required.
