Retention

Data is tracked on an annual basis in alignment with the Federal IPEDS reporting requirement. Programmatic data for this reporting period is not available. The aggregate percentage for all Bachelor degree-seeking students is 69%.

Graduation

For all students, regardless if they are first-time full-time students or transfer students, the average time it takes to graduate is 2.5 years. This is calculated annually as part of annual reporting to CIDA. Based on data gathered since Spring of 2007, the average graduation rate for the Interior Design program is 76%.
