During these unprecedented times and processing the “new normal”, we realize more than ever the exceptional community and mutual respect upheld by our students, faculty and staff. It is that spirit of compassion, concern, and being careful that we recognize across the board and to which we are all committed. Even though the campus will remain closed until August 31st, it is now our collective responsibility to modify some of our behaviors in order to protect our Rocky Mountain College of Art + Design community as a whole.

Please know that we are taking reasonable steps to provide a safe working environment for all of our students, faculty and staff. We continue to monitor updates from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, OSHA, as well as the State of Colorado and Jefferson County authorities.

We have implemented specific protocols to ensure proper social distancing, use of facemasks, enhanced disinfecting and cleaning, symptom attestations that could restrict access to campus, and restricted non-essential travel. We need to continue to ensure that all individuals who have tested positive for COVID-19 or have been exposed to individuals who tested positive are not on the RMCAD campus for the time periods suggested.

However, given the nature of the situation, we cannot and do not warrant that the measures will fully protect anyone from exposure to COVID-19. Precautionary measures that we all must take are not intended to serve as substitutes for professional medical advice, health and safety measures recommended by governmental agencies, and/or good practices, such as social distancing, staying home when sick, and frequent hand washing. Even with the best safety precautions, we all assume some risk when we interact with others. Individuals within high-risk categories should consider whether returning to campus is in their best interests by consulting with medical providers.
