Pursuant to the Colorado Revised Statutes [Title 23](#), 23-5-123 Campus sex offender information, RMCAD's Department of Safety and Security provides the following links and information which may be used to gather information regarding Registered Sex Offenders (RSOs), including Sexually Violent Predators (SVPs), in Colorado. In addition to compliance purposes, the Department of Safety and Security provides these links as a community safety and awareness tool. **Please note that any action taken by you towards a registered sex offender, including but not limited to vandalism of property, verbal or written threats of harm, or physical assault against this person, their family, or employer, can result in your arrest and prosecution.**
