

HOUSING OPTIONS

RMCAD does not currently offer on-campus housing, however there are many college housing options available in the area. First-time freshmen are encouraged to apply to the Assembly Student Living, The Villas, Auraria Student Lofts, or COLAB Apartments, which offer safe, affordable housing with student-centered communities. Additionally, many RMCAD students choose to find apartments in the areas surrounding campus. It is important to note, student housing options do not include meal plans.

OTHER HOUSING OPTIONS

There are many apartment complexes and rental options available within close proximity to campus. The property listings we have on our site include locations where previous students have had success and where access to campus has been easily available. You can see the frequently updated list here: mcad.edu/housing.

APARTMENTS

Student housing is generally more affordable and more convenient for students. However, there are many apartments available in nearby locations such as Lakewood, Edgewater, and Wheatridge. For students who don't mind a short commute before and after class, Golden, Arvada, Thornton, Westminster, and Littleton are also great areas to look for housing. Students that are looking for something closer to Downtown should consider Capitol Hill, Wash Park, and the Baker area. To minimize rental costs, we recommend students live with at least one roommate.

- » \$1,800 average cost for one-bedroom apartment
- » \$2,500 average cost for two-bedroom apartment
- » Utilities and internet not included
- » Water, trash, and sewage billed with rent, but prices can fluctuate monthly
- » Most apartment units are not furnished
- » Utilize third party furniture rental company to furnish spaces before moving in
